SCHOOL REGULATIONS

The main objective of St. Theresa Girl's Secondary School, Bwanda is to educate responsible and hardworking students in a peaceful and loving atmosphere to become good, useful and developmental citizens of the society and country. Hence the following set of rules act as a guide towards that end.

1. A student must respect all school authority, her schoolmates and herself.
2. Students are strictly obliged to obey the head – girl, her assistants and other school leaders. Failure to do so implies a suitable punishment.
3. Staff quarters are strictly out of bounds to students except with the permission of the Headmistress.
4. Drinking alcohol and smoking or in possession of the related materials, e.g. cigarettes, alcohol, and drugs is strictly forbidden. Any student that violates this rule is liable for dismissal.
5. Students are forbidden to be possession of the following, radios, cell phones, candles and clothes other than those recommended by the school. Any student found with them will receive an appropriate punishment and the items will be indefinitely confiscated.
6. Going off the school campus or spending a night outside without permission amounts to self – dismissal.
7. Any student found guilty of the following; stealing, fighting, immorality or practicing sorcery shall be liable to immediate dismissal.
8. Pregnancy and abortion are unacceptable in school. Any student who becomes pregnant or commits abortion shall be liable to immediate dismissal.
9. Students are responsible for any school property entrusted to them. Any loss or damage to that property must be compensated for.
10. Speaking English is compulsory all the time.
11. All the students must observe obligatory days (as programmed by the school) of worship and ought to say their morning and evening prayers together.
12. Every student must attend all classes and preps.
13. Every student must strictly observe silence and order in the dormitory after the last bell.
14. Absolute silence must be observed in the classroom during prep – time, in the library and laboratory sessions. Order and discipline must be strictly observed during the lessons.
